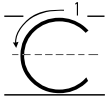


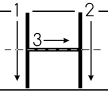

After a lengthy search, and several interviews, our school has hired some remarkable people. As the school administrator, I am pleased to introduce you to our new teachers!

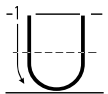
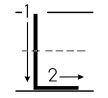
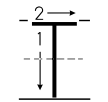
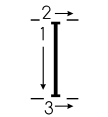


1st and 2nd Grade: Mrs. Margaret

interview revealed her to be an intelligent, organized and creative teacher, prepared to bring awesome education and experience to our kids.

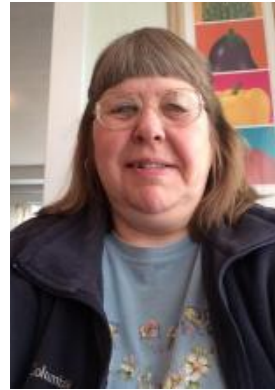
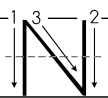
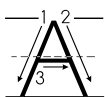
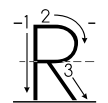
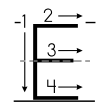
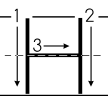
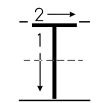


3rd and 4th Grade: Miss Courtney Henry

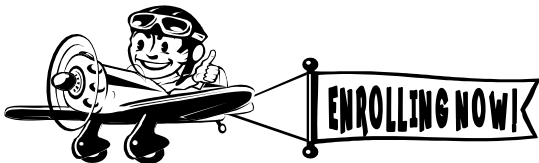


The first day of school is September 8, 2015. All returning families need to update their child's information if you haven't already. Please stop by the

Bonus Programs!!

For those of you that don't know, we have a couple of savings programs that you could take advantage of. First we have the recruitment bonus that is still available through the month of September. We have several families that have already received their discounts for the school year! Read up on the details in the box below.

RECRUITMENT BONUS



A Recruitment Bonus of \$100 off the first month's tuition during the 2015-16 school year to any school families that persuade a new student to enroll and attend Christ Lutheran School during the 2015-16 school term!!

The second program is for volunteering which a lot of you already do!

For every 20 hours (that you volunteer for the



school) you get your name put into a drawing that will be drawn every quarter at our Awards Assemblies. Your name can go in multiple times, so the more you volunteer the better chances of having your name drawn! The family drawn will receive \$100 off of their tuition! The hours/minutes you have logged get written in the visitor sign-in/out book located outside the office. The volunteer can be anyone that is able and willing to volunteer, i.e. parents, grandparents, siblings, etc., and it counts for your family. Just make sure that we know which family it is. We are also including attendance of PTL meetings, tasks completed at home, driving for field trips, along with classroom helpers, lunch duty, and other activities accomplished on site.
